Using the Microscope

When you are ready to start

- 1. Set up the scope and plug it in
- 2. Clean all lens, eyepieces and slides you will use
- 3. Turn on the light
- 4. Lower stage as far as it will go
- 5. Place slide in holder and center specimen over light
- 6. Click 4X objective into place
- 7. Raise the stage as high as it will go
- 8. While looking through the eyepieces, use the **coarse focus knob** to lower the stage until it is in the best possible focus
- 9. Use the fine focus knob to sharpen the focus further
- 10. Center the part of the specimen you wish to look at more closely
- 11. Click the **10X objective** into place
 DO NOT RAISE OR LOWER THE STAGE
- 12. Use the **fine focus knob** to focus the slide DO NOT TOUCH THE COARSE FOCUS KNOB
- 13. Repeat steps 10 to 12 to change to 45X objective

To use OIL IMMERSION;

- 14. Focus the slide with the High power (45X) objective
- 15. Move the objective lens out of the way (DO NOT LOWER THE STAGE!) apply a drop of oil directly on the part of the slide you wish to study.
- 15. Click the oil immersion lens into place
- 16. Open the iris diaphragm as needed, adjust the light.
- 17. Use the fine focus knob to focus the slide

DO NOT TOUCH THE COARSE FOCUS KNOB

When you are done

- 18. Lower the stage
- 19. Remove the slide, clean off oil, and put it away
- 20. Click 4X objective back into place
- 21. Turn off the light

- 22. Clean lens and eyepieces
- 23. Unplug and wrap the cord around the scope
- 24. Put the scope in its assigned place
