

Factoring Hints

Steps For Factoring

1. Factor out Greatest Common Factor (GCF)
2. If it is a binomial, check for special factoring formulas (i.e. difference of two squares, sum of two cubes, and difference of two cubes)
3. If it is a trinomial, use "Trinomial Factoring methods."
4. If it contains four terms, attempt to factor by grouping (note: Usually one needs to group two-by-two, but occasionally, one needs to group three-by-one).
